**The following are requirements, recommendations, and instructions for your cat's upcoming surgery:**

Your pet will be required to have written proof of the following (if not performed here):

- \* Rabies & FVRCP vaccinations
- \* FELV/FIV Test

At the time of surgery, your pet will receive a full examination, anesthesia, bloodwork, and pain management.

If your pet has not been vaccinated within the past year, then these services will be performed on the day of surgery at your expense.

We highly recommend the following with all surgeries:

- \*Fecal: assists in identifying intestinal parasites (we will need to deworm any pet who has not been dewormed before)
- \*Intravenous Catheter: provides access to a vein to administer fluids and/or medications if needed for an emergency situation (required if your pet is over 5 years old).
- \*Oravet Dental Sealant: assists in the prevention of plaque and bad breath.
- \*Home Again Microchip: assists in pet identification.

Please remember that your pet should not eat after 7:00 p.m. the previous evening, but water is okay until the morning of surgery. Please bring your pet in between **8:15–9:00 a.m.**, and allow about 15 minutes to be checked in by a surgery technician.

**Please try to give at least 24 hours notice if you need to cancel your pet's surgery.**

**Please read all of the above information before your pet's appointment. Please make sure to bring this paper with you to check your pet in for surgery. If someone other than yourself is bringing in your pet for surgery, please indicate on this sheet which additional services you would like us to perform, or call ahead to let us know. Thank you.**
