Brushing your pet's teeth is beneficial for both your pet and your pocketbook. Advanced dental disease can be costly, not to mention painful to your pet. If you are unable to brush your pet's teeth daily, consider having a dental cleaning performed on your pet once a year.

“Senior at Seven”

Dogs don't age the way people do— they age much faster. Most dogs are considered seniors at seven years of age. Be sure to visit your veterinarian regularly.
